

Needle-Free Treatment for Diabetic Companion Animals



Dear Pet Owner,

Just because your dog or cat has been diagnosed with diabetes, doesn't mean that your pet's quality of life – or your life – has to change. And, you'll be happy to know that now you can effectively treat your pet's diabetes **WITHOUT NEEDLES**. Zoë, needle-free insulin jet, has been designed to take the pain out of daily insulin injections.

You'll love Zoë because it:

- Is easy to administer insulin. You and your pet will be more relaxed when it's time to give an injection.
- Allows multiple people to administer the insulin. If you are unable to administer the injection, a family member, neighbor, or pet sitter can easily administer accurate dosages of insulin without needles.
- Is clinically proven to be more accurate in dosage measurement than the needle and syringe.
- Eliminates accidental needle sticks.
- Allows you to do what you do best: provide comfort and a good quality of life for your companion animal.

Proven Effective

The same jet injection technology used in Zoë, was categorized as a class II medical device in 1985. It has been used to effectively treat and manage diabetes in humans for over 20 years. A design specifically for companion animals was tested by the Atlantic Veterinarian College, Inc. concluding that the technology is an effective method for treating diabetes in dogs and cats.

How Zoë Works

After insulin is loaded into Zoë, a press of a button releases a micro-jet stream of insulin through a tiny opening (0.006 in.) in the nose of the injector. Zoë uses a coiled spring to generate power and release a powerful stream of insulin. This stream enters the skin, disperses throughout the subcutaneous tissue, and is quickly absorbed. Zoë's accuracy and small penetration point results in reduced trauma to both the pet and its owner.

Getting started with Zoë
